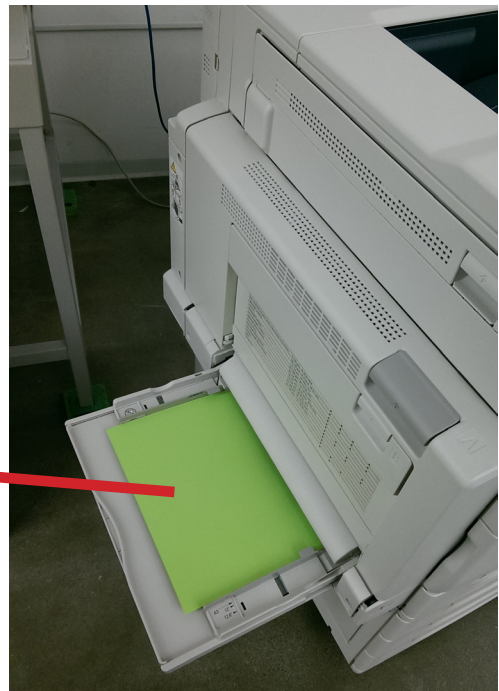
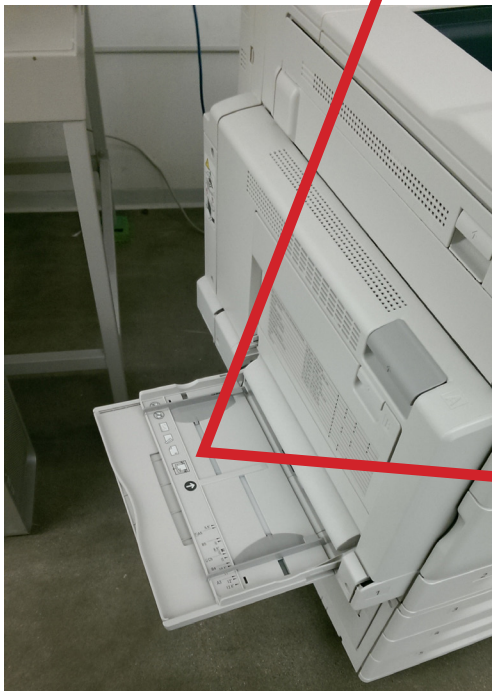

Before you put your fancy paper in, the screen on the printer should look like this.



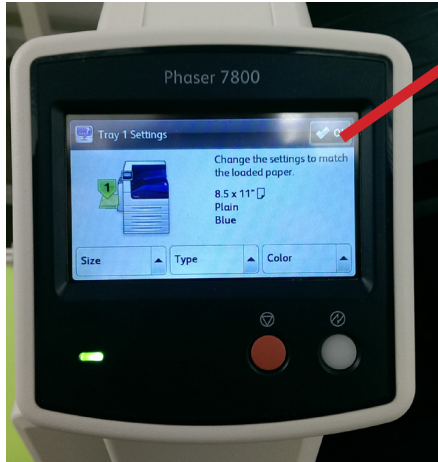

Place your fancy paper in the side tray of the printer.



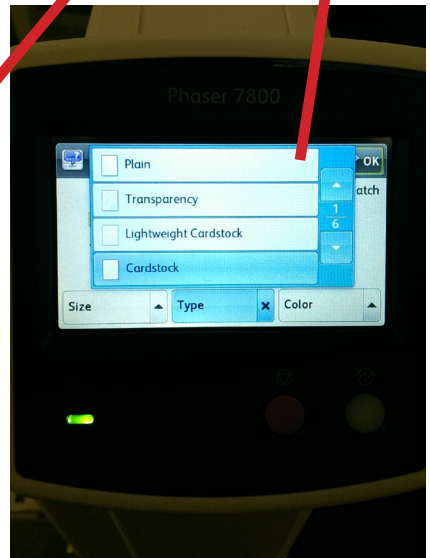
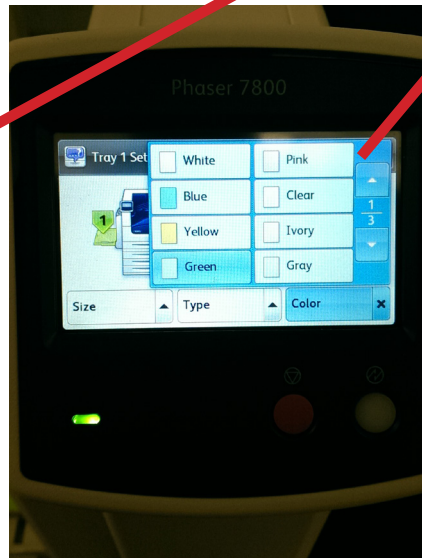
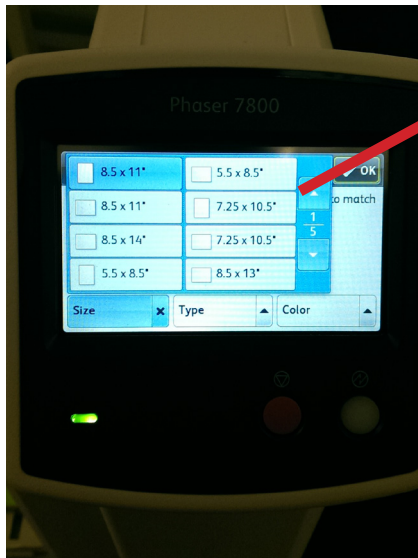

The printer will recognize your fancy paper and prompt you to verify size, color, and paper type. The screen should look like this.



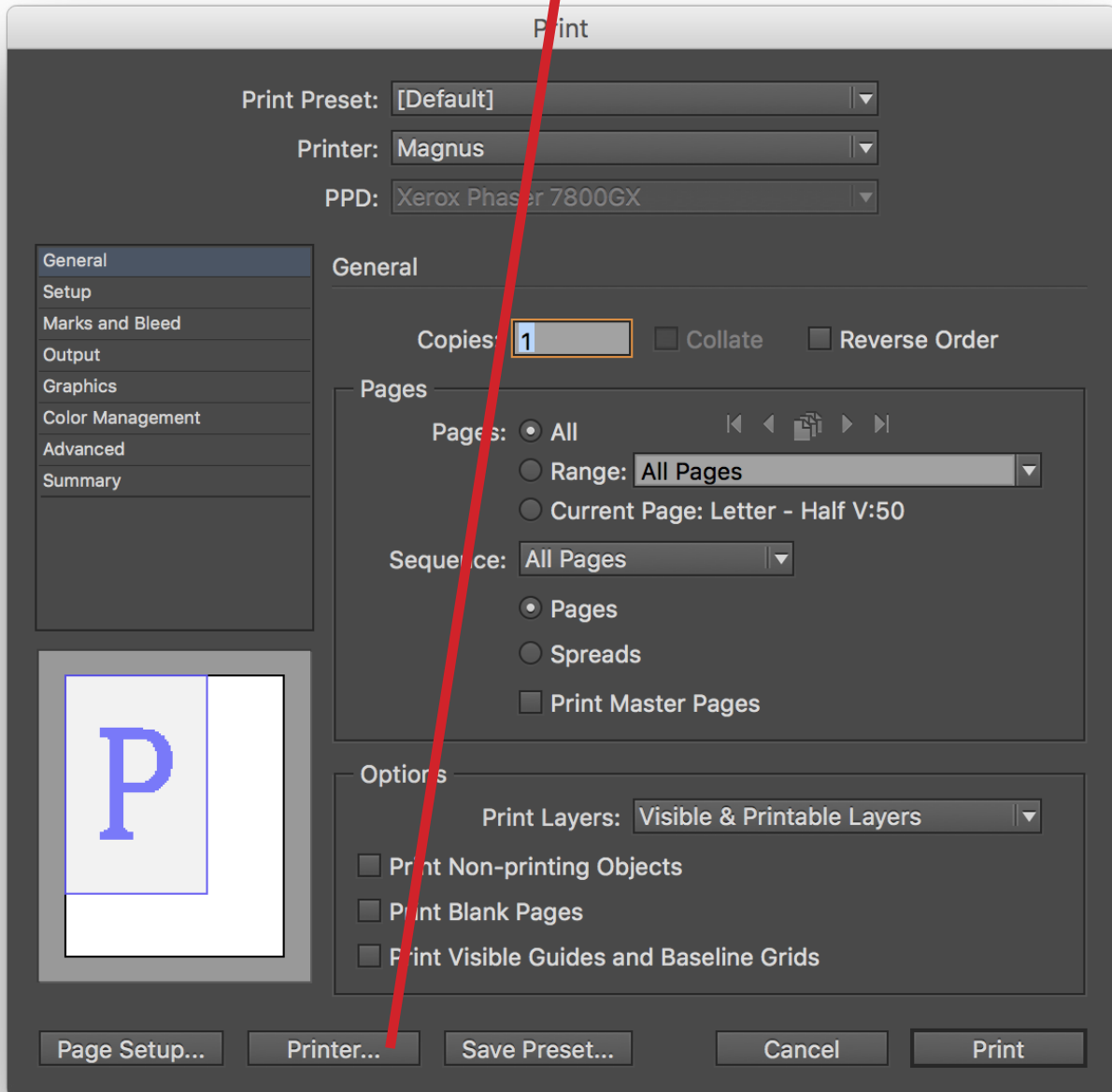

If the printer incorrectly recognizes your paper size, color, and type, use the menus on the bottom of the screen to adjust your paper size, color, and type.



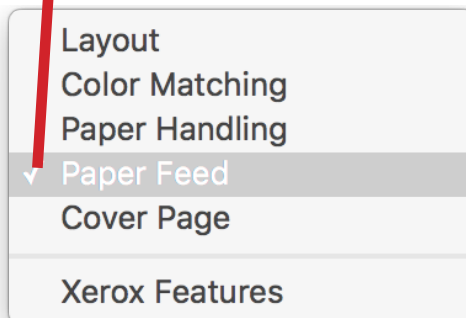
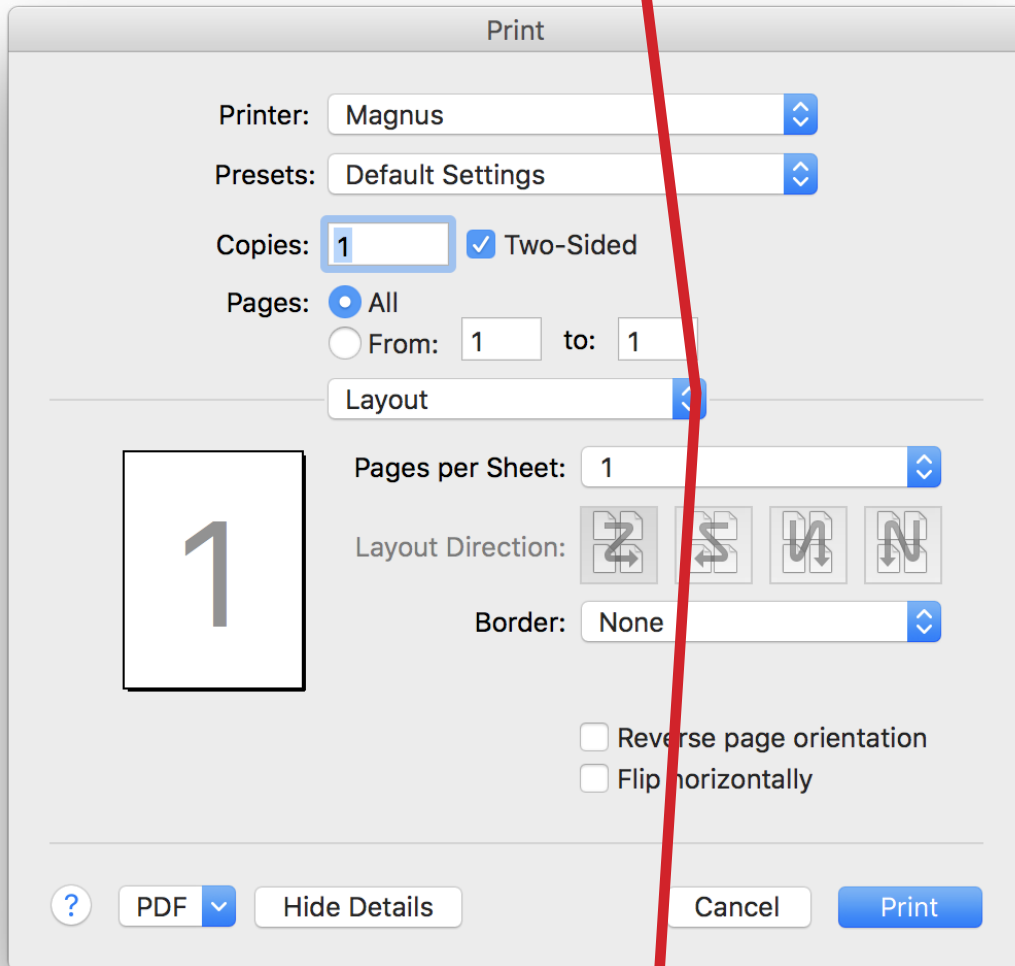

Select "Printer" or "Printer Settings" on the bottom of the print dialogue box. Depending on the software you're using, it could say either one.



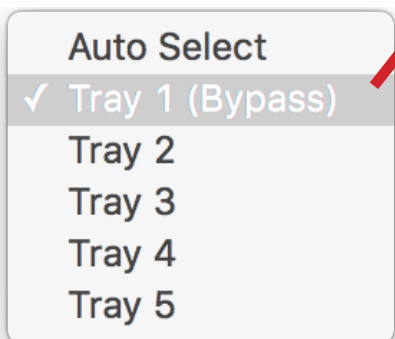
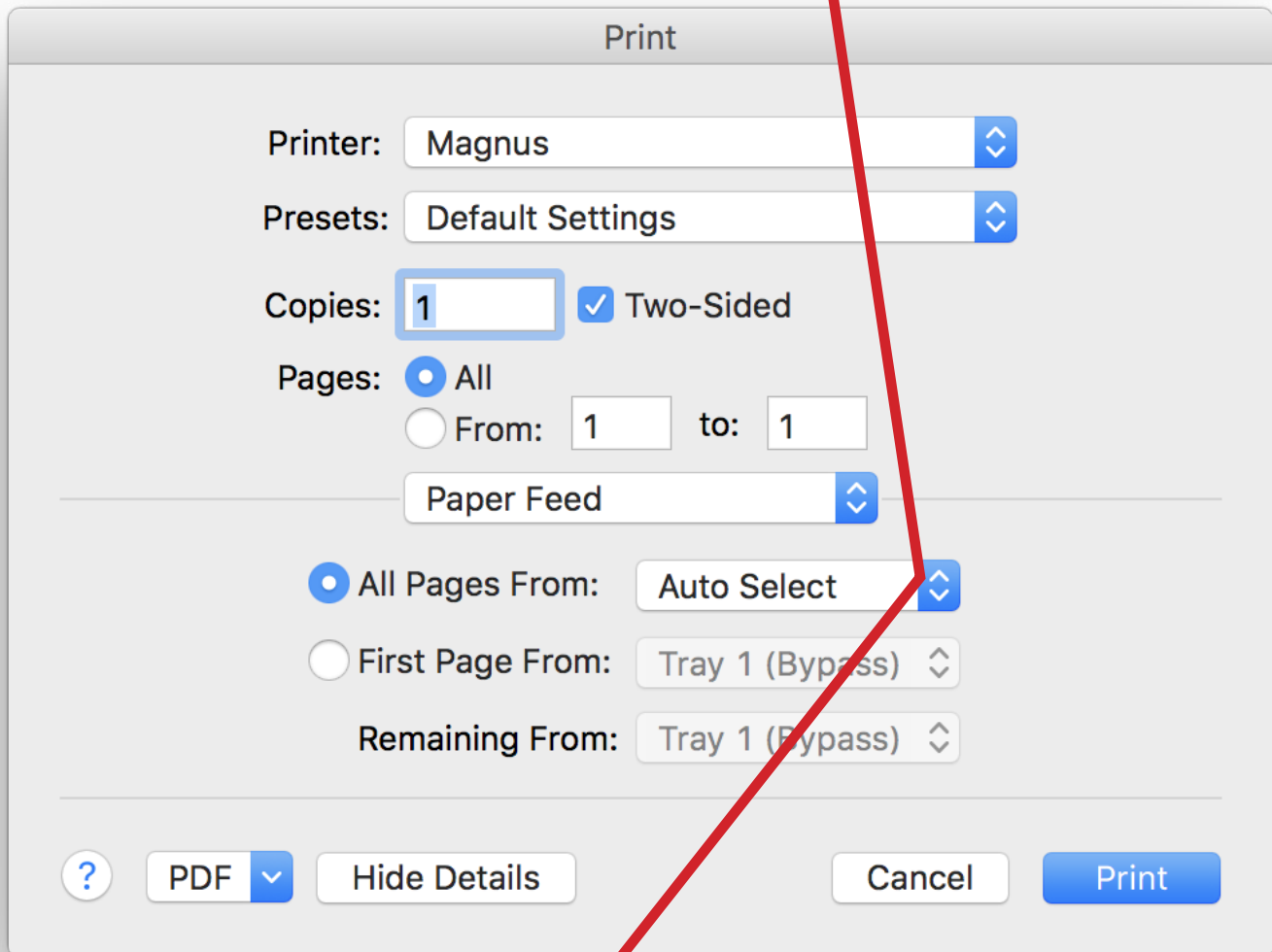

On the dropdown menu that says "Layout" select "Paper Feed."



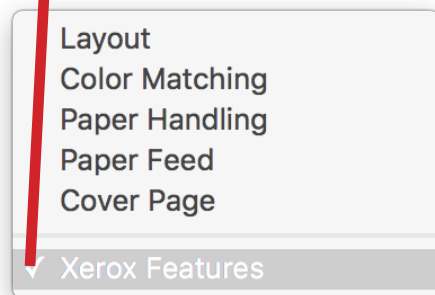
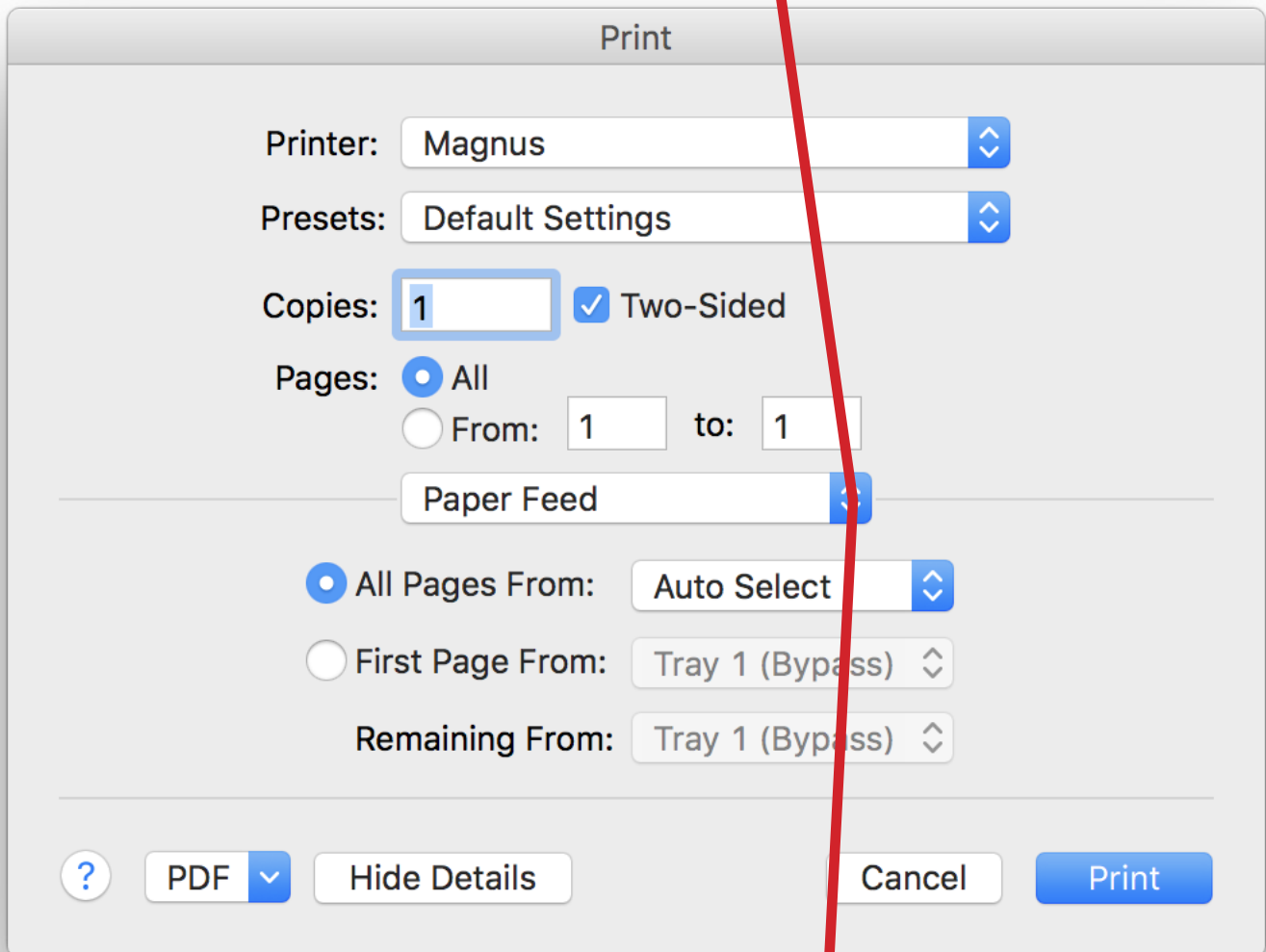
